The said property is settled land within the meaning of the Settled Land Act 1925 (hereinafter called "the 1925 Act") and is comprised in the settlement (hereinafter called "the Settlement") subsisting under or by virtue of the documents specified in the First Schedule hereto and the said legal estate in such property has by the Vesting instrument (hereinafter called "the Principal Deed") specified in the Second Schedule hereto been duly declared to be vested in the Vendor in fee simple upon the trusts of the Settlement affecting the said property and therein referred to and accordingly the Vendor has and can exercise over the said property the powers of a tenant for life under the 1925 Act
4. The Trustees are the trustees of the Settlement for the purposes of the 1925 Act as is stated by the Deed of Declaration specified in the Third Schedule hereto a memorandum whereof is endorsed on the Principal Deed


